What are your aims and objectives in providing the regulated activities and locations shown in part 3 of this statement of purpose

Our Health Partnership is a pioneering and growing organisation of 34 practices with 47 locations, 188 partners and c900 staff serving approximately 350,000 patients and was created to help realize economies of scale and to thrive in the face of continuing change in the healthcare system. Our model preserves our ability as practices to provide care in different ways according to the needs of our local populations.

Our Health Partnership is a single Super-Partnership, which is managed by a board of 10 including 9 elected GP Partners supported by an Executive Team of a Managing Director and a Chief Financial Officer. The Organisation is built around the concept of a profit centre model, where practices retain their own budgeting and operational autonomy, as well as retaining their own hard work for maintaining successful local links, maintain their ethos and identity within the OHP umbrella, operate autonomously, providing a seamless change for patient with GPs and practice staff retaining pre-existing contracts. The overall control is governed by a legal Partnership Deed.

Our Health Partnership delivers core GMS services from our 34 practices/ 43 locations. In addition, we deliver sexual health services through our locations and also deliver extended hours provision (Monday-Friday 6.30-8.00pm, Saturday and Sunday opening) across 7 hubs and these are:-

Description of the location

Lordswood House Medical practice is accessible by both car and by public transport and is located in a central residential area of Birmingham with good bus links to the City Centre. The building has disabled access for wheelchair users and has parking for disabled patients, as well as step free access. The practice offers several online services which include an appointment service, patient registration, repeat prescription. The practice runs a number of clinics which include a family planning/Well Woman clinic, a cardiovascular clinic, diabetic clinic, asthma/COPD clinic, stop smoking clinic, travel vaccinations clinic, child immunisation clinic, and a flu clinic. The practice also offers information for new patients for whom English is not their first language in the form of leaflets which have been translated in to many languages. The practice has ten Doctors, seven nurses, five HCA's and one phlebotomist. All of the of Doctors have up to date registration with the GMC and are educated to MBBS and MBChB in addition to possessing suitable medical indemnity cover. The nurses are up to date with their registration with the NMC. The practice is open six days a week and its telephone answering service also operates six days a week. The practice operates a walk-in blood testing session in addition to pre-booked early morning and late evening appointments for patients who are busy during the day. The practice also runs onsite clinics for audiology, paediatrics and neurology. The practice has a comprehensive website which outlines all of its services and opening times as well as the services it runs. The practice welcomes feedback through a patient participation group and has published a PPG report on its website. In addition, the practice has a very supportive team of reception, admin and management staff. The reception staff are very experienced in dealing with various patient enquiries and questions, the admin staff are very productive with regards to day to day processing of tasks. The management are responsible for the effective input of operational delivery and staff management. Lordswood House Medical Practice also offer a FFT (friends family test) whereby patients can give feedback on the service they have received. The feedback is then submitted on a monthly basis to the the HSCIC's Calculating Quality Reporting System. The feedback from the patients has been positive whereby 92% of patients would recommend the surgery to their friends etc.

Description of the location

Leach Hill Medical Centre is in the southern suburb of Birmingham. It is accessible by both car and by public transport and has reliable bus links to Birmingham City Centre. The building has disabled access for wheelchair users and has parking for disabled patients, as well as step free access. All the consultation rooms also have good access for disabled patients. The practice also has a parking bay for an ambulance and an onsite lift as well as RNID type talk for patients who have difficulty in hearing or speaking.

The Practice is staffed with seven Doctors, four nurses, one midwife, one HCA and one health visitor all the Doctors are educated to degree level from their Universities and have up to date registration with the GMC and adequate medical indemnity cover. The nursing staff are registered with the NMC. The practice is also adequately staffed with a large and experienced team of reception staff. The practice has an active patient participation group and patients are encouraged to join the group. The practice runs several clinics including child immunisation, antenatal, mother and baby, vaccinations, asthma, diabetes, minor surgery, cryosurgery, counselling and travel vaccinations. The practice maintains an up to date website whereby patients can find a variety of information on various topics. On the website patients, can also participate in a friends and family test. The practice has recently started to offer an extended hours service on Monday evenings and Thursday mornings and evenings.

We continue to provide the following:

Tudor Practice is part of the Sutton Group Practice. It has now merged with the following practices Sutton Park Surgery, The Vesey Practice, Ley Hill Surgery, Falcon Medical Centre and Dr AS Coutts and Partners (Four Oaks Medical Centre). The latter practices are now branches of Tudor Practice sharing the same list size.

We treat our patients as individuals and with courtesy and respect at all times, irrespective of their ethnic origin, religious beliefs, or the nature of their health problems.

Patients are provided with information about their own health. This may include:

- Any illness and its treatment
- Alternative forms of treatment
- Possible side effects of treatment
- Duration and development of the illness
- Likelihood of recovery
- How to prevent or avoid the illness recurring
- Any other information patients request unless they express a wish to the contrary.

In consultations we will signpost our patients to appropriate leaflets and websites.

Full information will be available on the services we offer in the practice, on our website and in our practice leaflet.

We aim to provide advice to prevent ill health wherever possible. For example our patients are advised to avoid smoking and if they drink alcohol they should do so sensibly and in moderation. Exercise is promoted.

Our patients can request routine vaccinations and immunisations for themselves and their children; this service is available within the practice.

Confidentiality is paramount within the practice. This will only be broken if in consultation with a professional organisation such as the Medical Protection Society or Medical Defense Union if it is thought that the patient is at risk or is a danger to themselves or others.

We undertake ongoing training of doctors and medical students. We always inform our patients at the time of booking their consultation and obtain written consent at attendance. Patients always have a right to ask anyone present, other than the attending doctor, to leave during an examination.

We will endeavor to provide a chaperone at a patient's request and will always acquiesce to the request to have another person present at the consultation. If we cannot provide a chaperone at the time, we will delay the consultation with a new appointment that is mutually convenient.

We will provide a consultation with the doctor or practice nurse within a time frame appropriate for the patient's medical condition. Patients will be offered a consultation for urgent cases within 24 hours. We offer appointments with our full time Advanced Nurse Practitioner in the Urgent Care Clinic as well as with doctors. Telephone triage and on line appointments are available.

Prompt referrals to another doctor or health professional when deemed appropriate will be made. Urgent referral letters will be ready for dispatch within 24 hours. Two-week appointments will be made for cancer referrals.

We will ensure all our staff, including clinical, administrative and reception staff, have the appropriate training and background to provide good safe care.

Repeat medication is provided on request in writing, using the right side of the script, on line and by electronic prescribing. Housebound patients only can make telephone requests.

Patients can make suggestions or complaints about the care given and the services we offer without jeopardising their care. The practice team should be the first point of contact for suggestions and complaints. It is helpful if it is made in writing. Reception and the website have information about this.

We work closely with our Patient Participation Group and actively encourage our patients to take part.

Patients have the right to leave the practice list and register with another practice within the practice area. If patients move outside the practice area they will be asked to change their doctor.

The Practice follows a zero tolerance policy towards violent, abusive or threatening behaviour and any person behaving in this way can expect to be removed from the list.
